The Kent Police Federation occupies premises that consisted of two former houses constructed in the late 1950s. The properties were linked together to form a suite of offices which, due to their age, required refurbishment and upgrading. Having gained planning permission for a new entrance lobby, extension, internal refurbishment and associated car park, Logic CP competitively tendered and secured the project.

The Police Federation are a progressive company and one of the key project drivers was to improve the environmental footprint of the property. Logic CP, through our dedicated supply chain, assisted the Police Federation in obtaining a government grant for the installation of roof mounted Solar panels.

The new extension and full internal refurbishment provided a DDA compliant space with offices, new internal staircases, upgraded toilet and kitchen facilities, access ramps, front of house reception and conference facilities. A project variation also required Logic to provide a new car park and access road to facilitate off street parking to the newly formed reception and by utilising the internal space and new link building the project has future proofed the Police Federation Offices for many years to come.



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
